### Montessori Methods for Dementia Care

Family members of a resident with dementia often question staff: "What can I talk about with mom/dad; how do I visit?" One way to engage with a loved one who has dementia is by incorporating activities based on the Montessori Method. The Montessori Method places an emphasis on a person's independence, freedom and respect for a person's physical, social and cognitive abilities. Developed in 1897 for children with special needs, this teaching process can also be used with individuals who have been diagnosed with dementia. Montessori methods are simple, modifiable and practical. They often incorporate everyday items that the resident is familiar with. Greenwood Court staff have been using the Montessori Methods in our Heritage home area for several years now. Starting next month, the Grapevine will highlight a different Montessori activity.
